1. Assignment Objectives as in SOW

- Train extension agents in a variety of extension methods
- 2. Impart training and communication skills to extension agents
- 3. Demonstrate farm training techniques to extension agents and selected farmer groups
- 4. Teach extension agents how to develop training materials from their own field experiences.



2. Achievement of the assignment objectives

Extension agents were trained in a variety of extension methods with several examples of how extension programs can be developed from the farmer level up. Methods of communication including radio, farm visits, field days, posters, bringing processors together with farmers, and on-farm demonstrations.



 Extension agents should commence setting out on farm demonstrations including completing the soybean holistic farming demonstration at the extension center.



4. Anticipated Impact

 Farmers will learn how to implement a holistic farming system which is simple but effective in producing excellent results in terms of crop yield, thus resulting in increased profits.



5. Recommended future volunteer Assistance

 There is a need for soil fertility training along with implementing soil testing as a service to area farmers.



6. Recommendations to other non-host stakeholders

 Encourage NGO's to support a soil testing and soil fertility training programming for extension agents.
