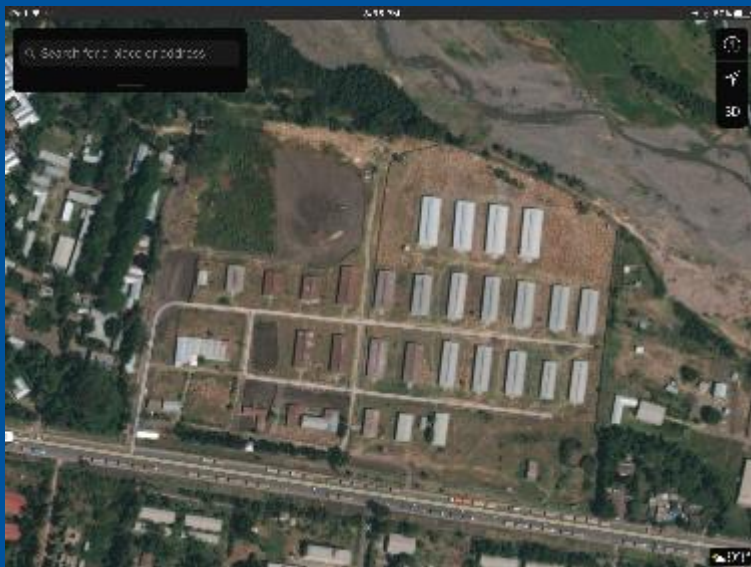

# 1. Assignment Objectives as in SOW

## **2. Achievement of the assignment objectives**

Visited the farm to assess the current level of knowledge of the farmers and farm management and to observe conditions on the farm, then trained the farm management and some farm works on how to improve biosecurity.



## 2. Achievement of the assignment objectives

We found that;

1. Farm needs to be separated into three parts for improving biosecurity
2. Limited efforts to control rodents
3. Holes in window screens that would allow birds to enter the house
4. Limited training of employees



## 2. Achievement of the assignment objectives

After touring the farm, I helped them look at ways to make and implement a biosecurity plan for their farm.

Additionally, conducted a training on biosecurity for the farm management and on a separate occasion for some of the farm staff



### **3. Recommendations to the host with regards to the assignment**

- Train all farm employees on biosecurity
- Use the training provided to teach additional poultry growers on biosecurity



## 4. Anticipated Impact

- Improved biosecurity
  - Biosecurity practices in place to prevent the spread of disease
  - Fixed housing for birds
  - Rodent control program
  - Farm drainage system
- Improved production as birds experience less disease



## **4. Anticipated Impact**

- Long term plans should include moving the breeders to a more remote area





## **5. Recommended future volunteer Assistance**

- Follow up on this assignment in 6 months to a year
  - See if biosecurity plan has been put in place



## 6. Recommendations to other non-host stakeholders

- Recommend that they work with local government work with poultry growers, agricultural providers and Universities to improve biosecurity in the area
